

Algirdas Biveinis is born in Rokiškis, Lithuania in 1992. Now he is in his Bachelor studies of Orchestral and Choral Conducting at the University of Music and Performing Arts Graz (Austria) with Prof. Marc Piollet and Prof. Johannes Prinz.

Actively participated in orchestral and choral masterclasses with Martin Sieghart, Johann van der Sandt, Maria Guinand, Jing Ling - Tam. Conducted Salzburg State Theatre Orchestra, Savaria Symphony Orchestra, Hradec Kralove Philharmonic Orchestra, Győr Philharmonic Orchestra. In the concerts conducted Film Music Orchestra at the University of Music and Performing Arts Graz.

In March 2018 conducted Film Music Orchestra of University of Music and Performing Arts Graz. At the Concert were performed Hannes Gill compositions Collage and Rückblick for Documentary Film "Die Grazer Gruppe" ("The Graz Group").

In the spring 2017 participated as Assistant of Mirga Gražinytė-Tyla in several Productions at Salzburg State Theatre.

Since September 2016 is working as a Conductor in the catholic organisation Caritas in Graz.

While studying at National M. K. Čiurlionis school of Arts twice has won the National Competition for Young Conductors in Vilnius, Lithuania.

Algirdas musical activities began in very early age. At the age of 4 he sang as the soloist in the holy Mass at the local church, in which his father was playing organ (3rd generation organist). His musical talent was noticed also by local music teacher, their cooperation has led to multiple winning of the National Singing Contest for Children and Pupils.

In 2012 graduated the National M. K. Čiurlionis school of arts (Choir conducting prof. R. Gražinis). From 2012 is studying at the University of Music and Performing Arts Graz, Austria. Among the Professors were Prof. Martin Sieghart (Orchestral Conducting), Günter Fruhmann (Korrepetition), Wolfgang Bozic (Opera Practice).
